




- Suggestions for developing a working relationship among businesses, labor organizations, and educational personnel



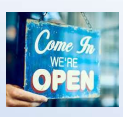




